**Location:** Maple Valley, WA

**Date:** July 9th, 2006 (Sunday). Held under USCF rules and permit 2006-408 (pending).

**Course:** The Ravensdale-Cumberland Road Race features a rolling 28 mile loop in rural SE King County. While there are no sustained climbs, the course is constantly undulating and includes a combination of wide roads with shoulder and winding narrow roads, which should be favorable to a small break staying away. Pavement is good to very good. The loop features one very short and steep climb (0.15 mile long, 20% grade). A course map and profile can be found at <http://www.vision4corners.com/>

**Cost:** \$20 pre-registration or day-of-race.

**Pre-Registration:** Online registration through 7/7/06 at Active.com (transaction fee applies) or send a check payable to "4 Corners Cycling-Michael Kopp" AND a completed USA Cycling Standard Release Form (available at [http://www.usacycling.org/forms/rider\\_release.pdf](http://www.usacycling.org/forms/rider_release.pdf)). **Day of Race:** Registration opens at 7:30 am and closes 20 minutes prior to the start of each race category. All participants must register or check-in 20 minutes before their race. Pre-registered racers will have an express check-in line.

**General Information:** Minimum category field size is 30 or categories may be combined. Maximum category field size is 75 for Men 4/5 and combined Masters Men, 50 for Women 4, and 100 all other categories. USCF license is required. A one day license is available at registration only to Men 5 and Women 4 participants. Annual USCF license available at [www.usacycling.org](http://www.usacycling.org). If you have not received your USCF license you must bring a print out showing "Active" license status. WSBA jersey numbers will be used. WSBA members MUST affix their WSBA frame number. Rental numbers will be available at registration for a \$ 10 fee (\$ 5 refundable when number returned post-race). Out of state riders pay only a \$ 5 refundable deposit. Masters will be not use WSBA numbers---jersey and frame numbers will be issued at registration

**Directions from I-405:** Parking and race staging will be at Tahoma Junior High School in Maple Valley. Head to Renton on I-405 from either the north or south. Take exit #4 - SR 169 / Maple Valley - Enumclaw exit and head east through Maple Valley (about 14 miles). Turn LEFT on Kent Kangley---look for the DOT sign that says SR 516---the next major intersection is SR 169 and Kent Kangley. Take the first left onto Summit Landsburg Road and drive about 1 mile to Tahoma Junior High School (located on the left). Enter the school and follow signs to Race Parking. Carpooling is encouraged. DO NOT ENTER THE SCHOOL FOR ANY REASON---RIDERS DOING SO WILL BE DISQUALIFIED
